

2010 Summer Camp

Troop 73 will once again be attending the Marin Council Boy Scout Summer Camp at Camp Marin Sierra. We will be leaving Novato as usual on **Saturday, July 10, 2010**, and returning the following **Saturday, July 17, 2010**. We will be leaving from and returning to the parking lot at Good Shepherd church.

To register your Scout for summer camp fill out the attached **Troop 73 Permission Form** and turn it in along with your registration fee. All registrations for summer camp must be made through the Troop; *any scout not registered through the Troop will be charged the On-Arrival fee.*

In addition to the Troop permission form, the following forms will be required for your scout to attend summer camp with Troop 73:

- **Parent/Guardian Minor Activity Release Form** (*Council Permission Form*) - This form grants permission for the scout to participate in activities at camp. This form ***must be signed by both parents/guardians***. If there is only one signature the parent/guardian must indicate that they are the sole parent/guardian.
- **Current Medical Forms** – Your Scout must have a current BSA Medical form on file with the troop prior to departure for camp. The old version will no longer be accepted at summer camp.
- **Parental Informed Consent and Hold Harmless/Release Agreement** – This is actually part ‘C’ of the new medical form, but it is required by the council to attend camp.
- **Special Dietary Needs Form** – If your scout has any special dietary needs please follow the directions on this form. If the Troop does not receive a copy of this form it will be assumed that there are no special dietary needs for your Scout.
- **Troop 73 Medicine Form** – One form will need to be filled out for each medicine your scout will be taking in camp, and will be turned over to the troop Medical Officer or Scoutmaster.

These forms are to be turned in to the Troop *no later than two weeks* prior to our departure. All of the above forms will be made available at the Troop 73 website (www.troop73.us).

There will be more information about summer camp in the Leader’s Guide and the Parent’s guide, both of which will be posted to the Troop website (www.troop73.us).

Please indicate on the permission slip if you are available to drive up to or back from the camp. We have not had to leave any campers behind yet and would like to keep that record going.

Individual Scout Fees for Summer Camp 2010

Early Bird Fee - Paid in full on or before March 29, 2010. **Includes free camp T-shirt.**

Scouts \$280 Adults \$100 New Scouts or bridged Webelos \$280

Regular Fee - Paid in full after March 29 but on or before May 31, 2010.

Scouts \$300 Adults \$110 New Scouts or bridged Webelos are still \$280

Late Registration Fee - Paid in full after May 31 but no later than June 28.

Scouts \$320 Adults \$120 New Scouts or bridged Webelos are \$300

On-Arrival Fee - After June 28th or upon arrival.

Scouts \$340 Adults \$130 New Scouts or bridged Webelos are \$320

Refund Policy:

The following is the Council's policy on refunds:

Full refund before 4/1/10; 50% before 4/30/10; 25% before 5/31/09; No refund after 6/1/09.

Applications for partial refunds may be sent in writing to the council office in the event of medical emergencies or death in the family prior to the camp session. In no case will we give full refunds after 4/1/09 because camp fees are already being applied to the number of campers registered.

The Troop refund policy will be the same as the council's. However, if a replacement can be found to take your scout's place, a full refund will be provided by the Troop once the replacement has paid the Troop.

ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST BE MADE THROUGH THE TROOP. YOUR SCOUT MAY BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CHARGES TO THE TROOP CAUSED BY ANY REFUND REQUESTS MADE DIRECTLY TO THE COUNCIL OFFICE.
